Confirmation

At the time of Baptism the parents are commissioned as the primary educators of their children in the faith.

As we approach the season in which our parish starts to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation, which is the confirming of our Baptism and through which we receive the Holy Spirit in His fullness, it is time for parents to consider the readiness of their children to receive this important sacrament.

Keep in mind that determination of readiness is to be based on a child’s awareness of God in his or her life, the willingness to follow Jesus, the importance of worship and getting to know their God and their faith, as well as the parents’ readiness to support the child in his or her commitment to Eucharist, through regular attendance at Mass and faith formation. The parish, too, has the responsibility to support both the children and the parents in this goal through prayer and by providing educational opportunities, both in faith formation and preparation for this sacrament.
