Confirmation

Preparation sessions for candidates will begin on October 1st. and will be held every Monday, at 7:15pm. at St. Ann Church, ending on November 12th. The sacrament of Confirmation will be conferred on November 15, 2007.

Registration will begin August 22nd. Please call 324-7121 to register your children. Deadline is September 10th.
