Write notes to Brother(s) in Christ or Dear friend. Do not write your last name at the end of the letter - just Brother or Sister in Christ or Friend or your first name.

Do not put the spiritual bouquet in an envelope.

30 men will be making the **REC**. You may write 30 letters. (all the same is okay) Please have spiritual bouquets in the boxes in church by May 1st. You may give your spiritual bouquets directly to Chuck and/or Mary Ann Flansburg who, being on the Elmira **REC** team, will see to it that the spiritual bouquets will get to the prisoners.
