Confirmation

Did you know that a Catholic had to be **baptized and confirmed before** he could receive First Communion, up until the early 20th. century? In 1910 Pope Pius X moved the time of First Eucharist from **after** an individual was confirmed to the age of reason which is considered by the church to be 7 years of age.

The church is now looking at re-establishing the original order of the sacraments called the Sacraments of Initiation, which are Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.
