Stewardship

Jesus is the perfect steward - watching carefully over all who had been entrusted to Him by the Father and sending them all out into the world in service. May I similarly protect and wisely use the gifts entrusted to me!

...Stewardship by the Book, by Sharon Hueckel

Jesus was not only the perfect steward in His own life - He was **raising** stewards. They went wherever Jesus went and saw how He taught and served. Jesus taught them to **live** the Word of God, and how to **give**, and how to **serve** God's beloved people. He raised them up to know that loving someone is in what you are willing to give up of your **self** to get that person to heaven - loving a person is not in how *they* make *you* feel. It was their witnessing Jesus, living the Word of God, and their hands-on training, that made them able to pick up where Jesus left and build the church we are today. Am I raising up stewards as Jesus did? We call the stewards, Jesus raised up, *disciples. Disciples are disciplined.* They were adults that became disciplined. Could any of them have ever said that they didn't want to go or do something that Jesus wanted them to do? Might they have whined about it? Jesus knew the bigger picture. He raised these people up to do what they didn't necessarily *want* to do (or *feel* like) and to do it for the bigger picture. That bigger picture includes me.
