Faith In Action GHA Thanks You !!

Faith In Action volunteers from Our Lady of the Valley are busier than ever, and very much appreciated for their generous gifts of time and caring. During the first quarter of 2007, we logged 294 hours helping on 146 occasions. Transportation, as expected, was the largest activity, representing over 66% of the total hours. The second quarter skyrocketed, with hours totaling over 400 as we helped clients 193 times. Translating services to a dollar value results in over \$9,000 provided. During this period, transportation was again foremost, with 312 hours involved and over 18,000 miles traveled. These statistics are for our parish, only!

We thank our wonderful volunteers for their faithful service and ask others to consider offering their assistance. Friendly visits, light housekeeping, minor home repairs, telephone reassurance, yard work, respite care, home bookkeeping and transportation are all needs we try to meet for our frail elderly population.
